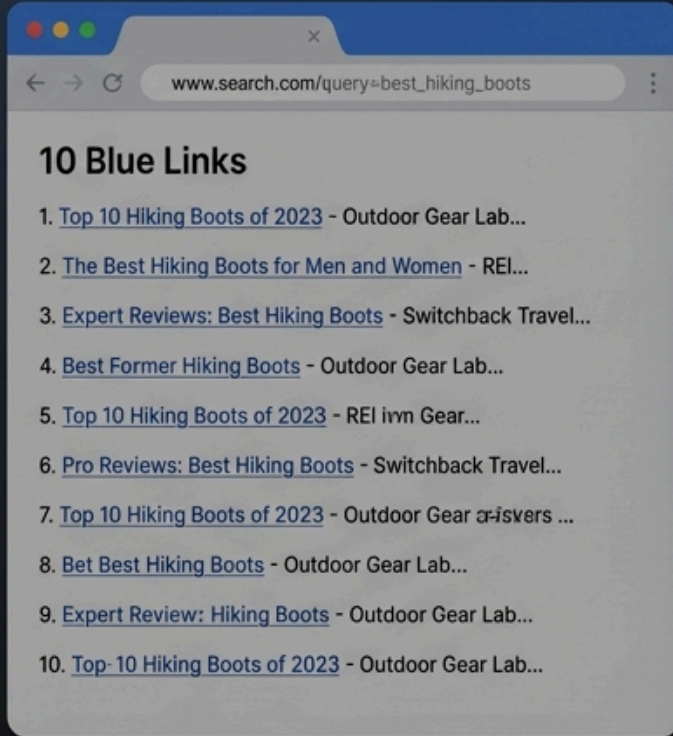


From Search Engine to Doing Engine.

AI Search Tab

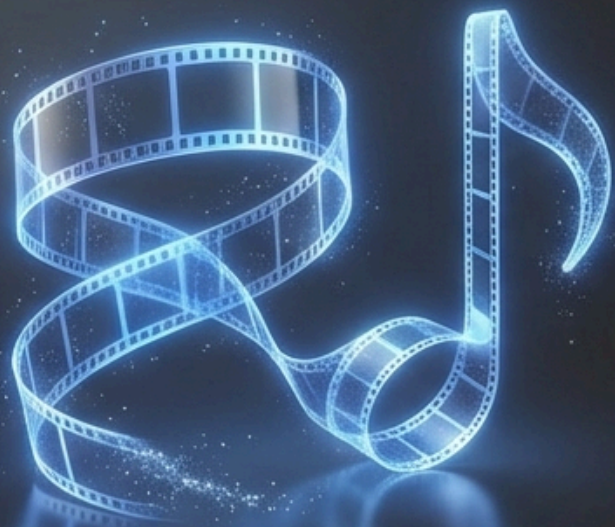
Understanding context over keywords. Search now processes multi-step reasoning.

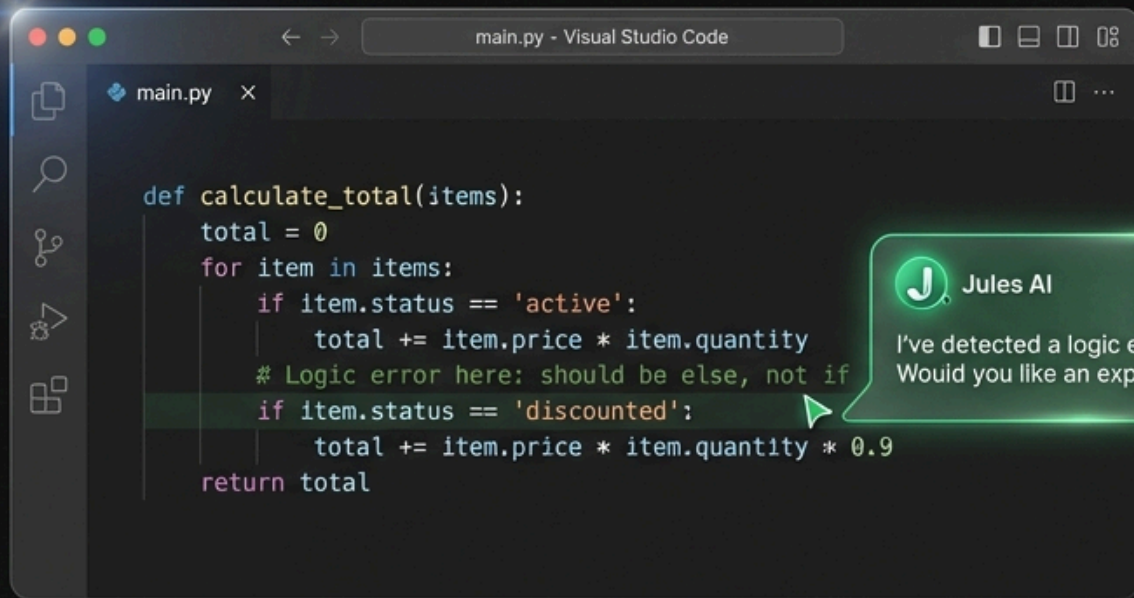

Jules AI: Coding & Debugging

A heavy-lifter for professionals. Mariner automates complex web-based workflows, handling repetitive navigation and data entry tasks autonomously.

The Future Interface: XR Glasses



AI leaves the screen to provide real-time assistance for travelers and professionals in the physical world.

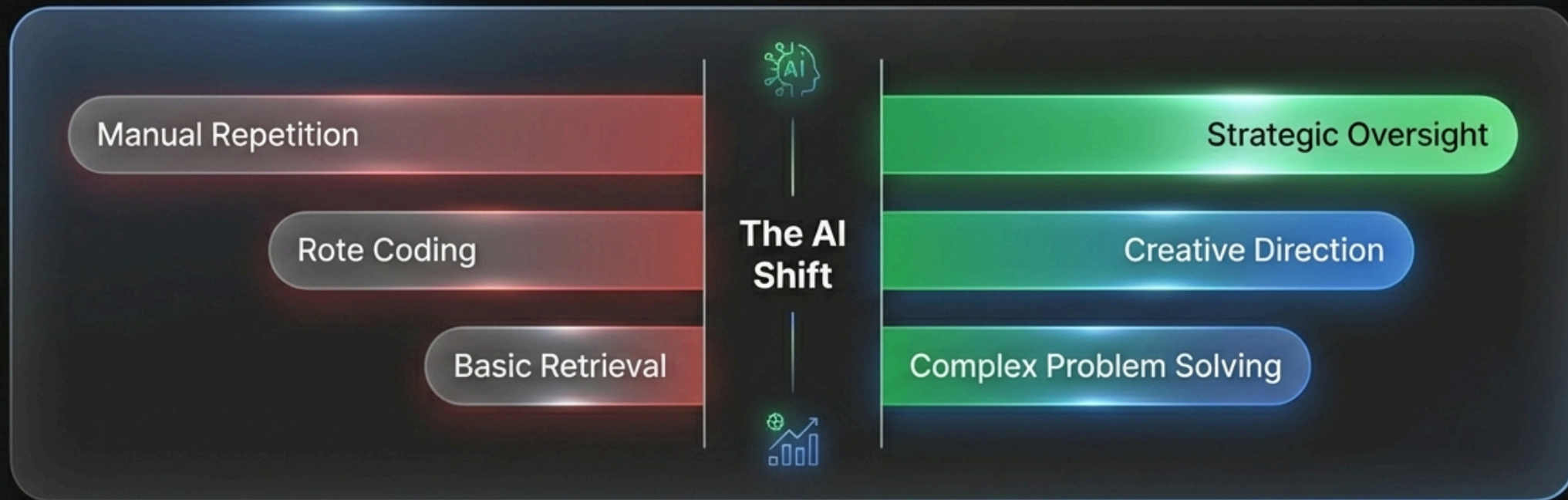


Status: Currently a demonstration of multimodal capabilities.
